This month's update: The Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) published regulations Prior news: The City of Billings is expecting a \$1,211,321 allocation in HOME-ARP funding, 15% can be used for administration (\$181,698) and \$1,029,623 can be used for projects and activities. City staff must prepare an Action Plan amendment. Funding is prioritized to provide housing for those who are experiencing, or are at-risk of, homelessness including: tenant-based rental assistance; and the development of affordable housing. Additional activities may be identified in future HUD guidance. Funding must be expended by September 2030.
