	CDBG and HOME Application Guidance <i>The CD Board has an opportunity to provide guidance on the CDBG and HOME application and allocation process. Last year's application and guidebook can be viewed online. Staff is recommending opening the applications for CDBG, HOME, and competitive CDBG-CV in early December and the deadline is in late January. The AmeriCorps VISTA Request for Proposals will also follow the same timeline. The CD Board will be able to take action at the December meeting.</i>	Brenda Beckett	Discussion
	American Rescue Plan: HOME-ARP Funding <i>This month's update: City staff is reviewing regulations and must first conduct a Needs Assessment for qualified populations: homeless; at-risk of homelessness; and / or fleeing domestic / dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking. Due to conflicting deadlines and timelines, staff will focus HOME-ARP program development in 2022. Prior news: The City of Billings has been allocated \$1.2 million in HOME-ARP funding. Fifteen percent can be used for administration (\$181,698) and \$1,029,623 can be used for projects and activities. The FY2021-2022 Annual Action must be amended to carry out HOME-ARP activities; funding must be expended by September 2030. www.BillingsMT.gov/HOMEarp</i>	Brenda Beckett	Report
