Unanimously approved.</p> <p>SB 291 / SB 292 – Issues related to bonds, election percentages, thresholds of approval – Monitor – Should be review</p> <p>SB 317 – Partisan local elections – Monitor</p> <p>HB 430 – Rent local program established with tax on short term rentals – Monitor</p> <p>LC 1251 – Big planning bill – Should be coming out soon</p> <p>HB 76 – BARSA</p> <p>HB 267 – SAFER account for federal highway grants</p> <p>HB 324 – Local government expenditure limit – Hard cap on all government expenditures – Move to oppose Rupsis/Neese – Withdrawn</p> <p>HB 355 – Use \$267M from surplus for infrastructure – Granted to county, not city. Would be nice if this were setting up a revolving loan fund.</p> <p>LC 4414 – Allocate \$17M to water treatment plant / trails</p> <p>SB 47 – CDL changes – Probably dead</p> <p>HB 226 – Change PERS allocation requirements</p> <p>HB 283 – Change powers denied re: landlords – City supports and MLCT opposes.
