The bill is ok if we can use our current zoning regulation, such as, yard width, setbacks etc. <p>HB 492 Oppose moving from 2 car parking to only 1 car parking at a residence We would like to remove daycares from this list as we believe they need parking standards. Assisted living parking is ok.</p> <p>SB 231 Tabled. We would like an amendment on all tax bills to allow cities with charters it use 15-10-420 which would allow for the adjustments in the value of a mill. We would like this to give us time to go to the voters and change the charter.</p>
