TOPIC #2	New city hall – status of work session table setup, grand opening, sound issues, etc.

NOTES/OUTCOME	<p>The work on the third elevator is completed, but we are waiting for the programming. It should be completed in a few weeks. After this the 1st and 2nd elevators will be taken offline to be repaired as a unit.</p> <p>It was decided to wait until fall to have a grand opening of the new city hall until after all three elevators are up and running.</p> <p>Next, we discussed the shape of the tables being used for work sessions.</p> <p>There were 4 different configurations of tables plus the dais that have been used since we moved into the new building. We thought it would be wise to ask the council members which one they like. Kevin will send a diagram to the Councilmembers for their opinions. We had a lot of discussions about the speakers and sound. Kevin stated that other folks use one or two standup mics rather than the 12-14 we use.
