<b>NOTES/OUTCOME</b>	<p>Lora started the presentation with a series of slides with proposed transportation planning projects.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Traffic and trail counter upgrade and replacement as the units are getting old.</li><li>2. Support the City of Billings Transportation Corridor Analysis with Travel Demand Modeling</li><li>3. Update the 2017 Household Travel Survey</li><li>4. Feasibility and Planning study of the alkali Creek Trail Connection</li><li>5. Feasibility and Planning study of the Downtown Connector to Coulson Park</li></ol> <p>Next, she showed the 6 recommended projects for the Safe Routes to School issues.</p> <p>St. Francis Catholic School Medicine Crow Lewis and Clark Poly Drive Castle Rock Billings Catholic School</p> <p>She indicated that only two from this list could be accomplished each year, so this would be a three-year project.</p> <p>Lorz then stated this is their list and that the city council to add, delete or make changes to the list.</p>

	<p>Additional projects for discussion were.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. ITS Study. This is the sensors, communications, data analytics and automation to improve safety for transportation networks.</li> <li>2. King Ave East- from South Billings Blvd to Laurel Road. Do to the traffic and Amen Park, a study should be made concerning the flow of traffic and parking in the area as the two new project, Ice and Rec centers go on line.</li> </ol> <p>Suggestions from the people attending were to have photos or maps of the areas in question to help in recognizing the areas in question and also prioritize the areas that staff believe should be completed first, second, etc.</p> <p>All this information will be given to the city council for the June 16<sup>th</sup> meeting.</p>
