- Project update from Library Director and Will Bruder
 - Cochran reported that:
 - The concrete slabs have been poured, structural steel should be delivered this week and masonry work should begin next week.
 - Bruder reported that:
 - Jackson Contractor Group went to Arizona to meet with Will Bruder Architects.
 - The OAC meetings continue to go well and there has been good progress with the pre-site work.
 - A Christmas tree will be placed and lit on the steel frame of the building on Christmas Eve.
- Report from Library Building Design Committee Co-Chair
 - Mickelson reported that:
 - The Committee will meet tonight, November 8 at 5:00 p.m. on the 3rd floor of the Library. The architects will have furniture samples available for viewing. The meeting will be followed by a public open house.
- Project update from the Foundation
 - Modrow reported that:
 - The Foundation, partnering with the School District, applied for an IMLS grant for a computer digital teen lab in the new Library building. She was just notified that the Library was selected for a \$100,000 grant to complete this project.
