February 1, 2019

1) **Legislative Session** – see attached report from Crowley Fleck.

SB 103 Appose – I testified against Senator Webb’s bill requiring all cities with more than 50,000 customers to have their utility rates authorized by the Public Service Commission. This bill strips authority away from local elected officials and adds significant cost to the utility. MLCT and Missoula also spoke against the bill with the Renters Association speaking in favor. We are optimistic the bill will die quickly. Senator Webb acknowledged to the committee that this bill is designed to hold the city of Billings accountable for the franchise fees we charged on water, sewer and garbage customers from 1992 – 2018.

HB 195 Support – Mayor Cole spoke in favor of the Local Option Tax Bill. The bill would allow all cities to have the opportunity to vote on a local option sales tax similar to what 10 Montana communities have been using over the past three (3) decades. The bill died this morning in committee.

SB 147 Support - Council member Ronning testified yesterday in favor of SB 147 to Revising laws concerning human trafficking and sex crimes to protect victims. Penny felt the hearing went well.

Legislative Video Conference - Yesterday the Mayor, Councilmember Ronning and I attended our community’s video conference lunch. The meeting was well attended by both Yellowstone County legislators (Penny was in Helena) and our community leaders – Penny mentioned that the hearing for SB 147 went well.

One Big Sky dinner event in Helena - The City, Chamber and BSED hosted a dinner event Tuesday evening to educate legislators. ~30 legislators and another 20 community members attended.

2) **Franchise Fee Lawsuit** – I’ve been working with Senator Roger Webb (one of the six (6) litigants in the case) to settle the lawsuit. Mr. Webb’s colleagues withdrew from the settlement talks in 2018. The City has been ready to discuss a settlement well before I arrived in November and ended the franchise fee when adopting the FY 2019 budget. I have a written settlement proposal from Senator Webb and will be working throughout the upcoming weeks to see if we can get traction on a settlement. If we don’t settle and win outright we will secure our authority to charge franchise fees and spend several hundred thousand dollars in legal fees. If we lose, we could be required to repay eight (8) years of collected fees, the opponents and our legal fees - together totaling ~\$16

million.

- 3) **One Big Sky** – As you prepare for your decision regarding the OBS Plan on February 11, please keep in mind what the resolution of approval says.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council that the City defines the term "approve" as it appears in this resolution as follows:

1. *The term "approve" means agreement with and acceptance of the Development Plan as a conceptual general framework for development designed generally to achieve the goals described in the Development Plan that establishes the One Big Sky Development District boundaries.*
2. *The term "approve" does not mean commitment to or adoption of any specific development agreements, project design, project location, policy, or public funding proposal that might be contained within the Development Plan. Similarly, the term "approve" does not mean any City commitment to or promise to enact any regulatory measure, specific tax, budget, or to appropriate public funds, approve a capital investment, adopt a land use control, or to approve any requests that seeks public funds for any One Big Sky Development-related purpose, and adoption of any specific land use control or solution, parking or transportation solutions.*
