

Billings City Administration Weekly Report

February 8, 2019

- 1) **Water Intake** - An update on the status of the Water Treatment Plant water supply. On Tuesday the Yellowstone River began to freeze over and water flows dropped significantly. Normally this time of year the river is flowing at over 1100 CFS; as of today the river is at 800 CFS. These flow levels are severely restricting water flow into our main intake. We are operating off intake 1 and intake 2 has been brought into operation to supplement water needs. We have also prepared to begin dredging the river if necessary to open up the main intake if the river flows drop any further. The water flow is normal to Livingston and then drops drastically as it approaches Billings. We believe the low flow is due to an ice jam somewhere upstream from us. The attached photo shows the ice around the river intakes.



- 2) **One Big Sky** – Much of the week was spent preparing for Monday’s City Council meeting. For those who receive hard copies of packet material they are in your mailbox at city hall.
- 3) **KOA** – Monday morning I met with Pat Hittmeier, CEO and Toby O’Rourke, President of KOA to introduce myself and discuss their plans to build a new corporate office. KOA has been downtown since 1962 and want to remain in the core, if they can find the right location.
- 4) **Orientation** – Brent, Andy and I had a great afternoon with councilmember Neese covering council orientation. We made it most of the way through the binder. We will

schedule a follow up session in the near future. Thanks for a great dialogue Roy!

- 5) **Federal Reserve** – Throughout the week, several community leaders have been meeting with the Minneapolis Federal Reserve staff. They selected Billings to pilot a new program to reach out and better understand the needs of communities throughout their district. They were particularly interested in talking to the city about needs for our more vulnerable citizens. This is a great opportunity to build a strong relationship with one of the federal government’s most influential divisions that can directly affect our economy. We will share their report when it comes out.
- 6) **Leadership Development** – The leadership team started our work building a stronger more effective team yesterday. Mark Willmarth, from Vision West spent the morning with our team. The focus was getting to know one another and to begin our work through The Advantage by Patrick Lencioni. Mark and I have been working together to build cohesive leadership teams since 2006. Trust, conflict, commitment, accountability & results are at the core of the work we will be doing. We will follow-up with Mark during a full day in late spring and an overnight retreat in the fall.
- 7) **Franchise negotiations** – Franchise negotiations continue with Charter. Annually the City receives \$1,399,359 through this agreement. The City approved a new agreement with Community 7 TV on 7/9/18 to pay them \$180,000 for FY19.
- 8) **Legislative Session** – see attached report from Crowley Fleck. Kevin, the Mayor and I will be in Helena next week for the Mayor’s/city manager’s conference on Wednesday and Government Day at the Capital Thursday.
- 9) **SBURA** – The South Billings Urban Renewal Association spent most of their meeting Tuesday night covering issues related to their agreement with Zeier Consulting. They approved a contract extension from December 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 and a repayment agreement with Zeier Consulting to recoup overpayments. Finance Director Zoeller is researching our records to make sure we understand how SBURA has managed their contracts with Zeier Consulting and any mistakes made. We have concluded that two (2) extra quarterly payments were made by SBURA and paid by the city over the three (3) year contract between 2016 – 2018 totaling \$76,845. We are researching our records relating to the prior contract covering 2014 and 2015 calendar years to verify accuracy. We will also be contacting an accountant or attorney to conduct an independent review in the upcoming.
- 10) **Neighborhood Task Force** – I had a chance to attend the North Park Neighborhood Task Force meeting. The group is enthusiastic about project re-code, USS Billings and calming traffic on 6th Avenue.
