

Billings City Administrator Weekly Report

May 7, 2021

- 1. Legislative Update** – The Montana Legislature adjourned on the 80th Day, April 29th, 2021. The Legislature saved 10 days as they expect to come back for a special session in July-August-September.

We have sent you the final report for the bills we have followed (with your assistance). We are still waiting to see how the more than 100 bills that passed the Legislature fare as they land on the Governor’s desk in the coming days and weeks. We will keep you apprised of the bills of interest on your watch list.

The governor signed SB358 which repeals the numerical Montana Nutrient regulations and replaces them with a narrative standard which is what the rest of our states in the region have. This video (<https://fb.watch/5is0XgEvY3/>) got a lot of play at the League of Cities and even NACWA (National Association of Clean Water Agencies) which helped to educate decision makers on the overreach of the nutrient regulations which take things too far and amount to more environmental harm than good. This also has a direct impact to our costs in that I don’t think we need the WRF Upgrade project now in **FY27 for \$60M.**

We can’t declare total victory yet because EPA still has to approve the rule changes that DEQ proposes, but this is a big step.

Greg and Aimee will join one of our council work sessions within the next six weeks to provide a wrap-up and answer questions. Attached is the Crowley Fleck End of Session Report.

- 2. Solid Waste Update** – The Solid Waste Division provided containers for Bright and Beautiful’s Great American Cleanup event. There were three locations where people could drop off the trash that they collected: Castlerock Park, the Community Center and Poly Vista Park. Solid Waste picked the containers up and there was 3.95 tons of trash collected and disposed of in those three locations!
- 3. Jail Discussion** – yesterday afternoon the county commissioners hosted a meeting to discuss challenges regarding the jail. The meeting was well attended by city PD and Admin., sheriff’s office, county attorney’s office, substance abuse connect and our downtown partnership. We will be having a follow-up meeting in two weeks. One of our many challenges is to collect good data to help understand the situation and be able to effectively communicate with the public, state legislature and department of corrections on the impact the State’s decisions are having on Billings.

4. **EV Gas Hose Cutting Ceremony** - This morning Mayor Cole, several community volunteers and our parking team showed off the city's first publicly owned electric charging stations. The stations were 90% paid for by a state grant (funded by the VW settlement) and are in the parking garage just east of Wells Fargo downtown. We also have 2 EV stations in the hospital corridor. Soon we hope to add a few more stations near the Northern and at the airport.

5. **Rose Park Playground** – We are excited to announce the completion of our new playground at Rose Park! This playground contains unique playground features not found anywhere else in the park system. This playground is also unique because it is the first playground that was selected by allowing the community to vote on their favorite design concepts! We are pleased to welcome the community to enjoy Billings' newest destination playground in the Billings parks system. 6. **Spring Arbor Day, May 12th** – Arbor Day is a day for celebrating trees! In Nebraska in 1872, J Sterling Morton proposed the idea of a day to plant trees, “Arbor Day”. On that day prizes were offered for the county that could plant the most trees properly. One million trees were said to have been planted on that first Arbor Day. By 1882 states across the country were celebrating Arbor Day.

Our parks are home to over 10,000 trees! The Parks and Recreation Department understands the many benefits that trees provide to our park users and community as a whole. From providing shade to storm water management, urban temperature regulation to increasing property values, trees have a larger impact on our everyday lives than we often recognize. The Parks and Recreation Department has a long history of celebrating Arbor Day and was recognized in 2014 as having one of the best Arbor Day Celebrations in the country. This year, we will continue our rich history by celebrating Arbor Day at North Park. Due to COVID-19 and SD2 travel restrictions, we will be holding two Arbor Day Celebrations. Our Spring Arbor Day is scheduled for May 12th and will consist of tree planting, volunteer projects, and park beautification projects. Our Fall Arbor Day celebration will be held on September 23rd and consist of Educational Booths for SD2 fourth

graders, the official Arbor Day Ceremony, and planting of the Arbor Day Tree. There is still time to volunteer! Go to Billingsparks.org/arbor-day/ to reserve your spot. Volunteers will be given a free Arbor Day T-shirt in appreciation of their efforts.
