

## Billings City Administrator Weekly Report

January 7, 2023

### 1. City looks for public input on updating ward boundary lines at open house.

**Where:** Billings Public Library Community Room, 510 N. Broadway

**When:** 5:30 p.m. – 7:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2023

**Why:** The City per its Charter must maintain its Election Wards and ensure there is fair and balanced representation. After every Decennial Census, the City reviews and updates its Ward Boundaries per population growth. City staff is working with the Mayor and City Council to make Ward Boundary adjustments prior to the 2023 election process for City Council elections.

**Who:** This session is for any interested members of the public in Billings who want to learn about the Ward Boundary Amendment process and specifically if where they live may be moved from one Council Ward to another one during this process.

**What will be presented:** We will have a brief PowerPoint with information on the process, access to an interactive web map of the draft Ward Boundary Amendments, and some static maps displayed of the specific areas that are changing, so residents can see what Ward they are going into in the six areas of town where we are making boundary adjustments. City Legal staff and City GIS staff will also be there for support and to help answer questions.

**What happens after this meeting:** Staff will take any comments and input from the public back to the City Council at a regular meeting in February so the Council can review the draft map a final time and take action on amendments. The amendments must be in place no later than March 2023, so the wards are updated prior to the election cycle.

### 2. 68<sup>th</sup> Montana Legislature - DV Prosecutor Ben Halverson testified in opposition to SB 12 on Thursday. The bill seeks to require local governments to pay for public defense for individuals being prosecuted through the enforcement of local ordinances. In prep for Ben's testimony, we held a conference call with Aimee Grmoljez and Steve Turkiewicz (our Helena lobbying team).
