

## Billings City Administrator Weekly Report

February 18, 2023

1. **Upcoming Citizen's Police Academy** - We would like to extend invitations to council to attend any or all CPA sessions. Schedule attached.
2. **Local Affairs, Legislative and Budget & Finance Committees** – each committee held meetings this week. Local Affairs focused on the interchange corridor study and the need to develop a water and sewer utility plan to realize the plan's vision. On the legislative front, a lot of bills stripping authority away from local elected officials are gaining support. There are way too many bad pieces of legislation to effectively weigh in on them all. Coming out of the transmittal deadline, we need to determine which policies necessitate deeper engagement. On a positive note, the six (6) Public Safety bills we have supported are going well but our efforts to shut down illicit massage businesses and manage marijuana may be stripped away. Budget and Finance reviewed budget amendments and ramped up their meeting schedule to biweekly throughout the budget process. Unfortunately, I was not well prepared to review all of the budget amendments scheduled for Council action on February 27, so I am asking the committee to hold an additional meeting Thursday or Friday of this week.
3. **Montanan Rescue Mission (MRM)** – yesterday we had a breakthrough with MRM to accept the city's grant for data collection. Once the agreement is signed it will be placed on the March 13 council agenda for approval.
4. **NCSC Zoom** – Judge Kolar, Court Clerk Park and I met with the John Bello National Center for State Court to discuss their court management and performance analysis work. We shared the council initiative and are working together to develop a draft scope of work. The city attorney's office and police department will also be included in the review. The group did work with Judge Knisley in 2018. The analysis is expected to take between 9 – 12 months once a contract is approved.

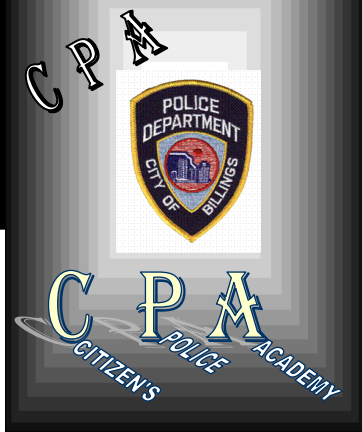
