

RESOLUTION NO. 12-19181

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO BILLINGS, MONTANA CITY CODE, ARTICLE 22 900: SALE, DISPOSAL OR LEASE OF CITY PROPERTY; DESCRIBING THE PROPERTY TO BE SOLD; DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE CITY TO DISPOSE OF THE PROPERTY; AND ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Billings finds it desirable to dispose of property it currently owns, located in the City of Billings, Yellowstone County, Montana, as follows; Lots 1-12, 20 and 21, block 245 of the Sugar Factory/Billings Second Addition according to the official plat thereof on file and of record with the Yellowstone County Clerk and Recorder

WHEREAS, Article 22-900 BMCC requires the city to declare its intention to dispose of such lands, giving the public the opportunity to be heard regarding such action, and

WHEREAS, Article 22-900 BMCC also requires that all property owners within three hundred (300) feet of the exterior boundaries of said property, be notified by mail, fifteen (15) days in advance of the time, date, place of public hearing and the City property's existing and proposed use.



The Billings City Council will conduct a PUBLIC HEARING on Monday, August 13, 2012, at 6:30 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers, located on the Second Floor of the Police Facility, 220 North 27<sup>th</sup> Street, Billings, Montana. The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of the public hearing in **The Billings Times** in its regular issues on July 19 and July 26, 2012 and to mail a copy of such notice to all property owners within the three hundred (300) foot notification area.
