

RESOLUTION NO. 12-19224

A RESOLUTION OF THE BILLINGS, MONTANA, CITY COUNCIL,
AUTHORIZING THE USE OF UP TO \$30,600 FROM FY 2013 CITY
COUNCIL CONTINGENCY FUNDS FOR ENGINEERING
CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE ROSE PARK POOL
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Rose Park Pool Improvements project was funded by Council as part of the City Wide Park District in Fiscal Year 2013 Budget. However this funding is not available until after taxes are collected on December 1, 2012.

WHEREAS, this project is critical to be completed by the beginning of the 2013 swimming season beginning June 3rd.

WHEREAS, it is crucial to begin consulting services immediately for the project to be completed on time.


WHEREAS, Parks, Recreation and Public Lands (PRPL) seeks funding for engineering consulting services in the form of a loan from the Council Contingency Fund to be repaid after December 1, 2012 when funding for the City Wide Park District becomes available.

WHEREAS, the \$30,600 Council Contingency Fund allocation is still necessary to move the project forward in time to open the new water slide features for the 2013 swimming season

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, to authorize the expenditure of \$30,600 from the Council Contingency Fund (Account 010-1110-411.79-70) for engineering consulting services for the Rose Park pool Improvements.


