

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING THAT THE STRICT REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDS IMPOSED BY MCA 7-5-4302 ARE NOT IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITY AND PRESCRIBING THE PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Officials that the Aviation Department is in need of boiler repair work; and

WHEREAS, the need has suddenly arisen; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to get the boiler repaired as expeditiously as possible; and

WHEREAS, the most expeditious methods of assuring the replacement as quickly as possible is to declare an emergency and purchase the repair work without advertising for bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. **EMERGENCY.** The City Council pursuant to MCA 7-5-4303 hereby declares that an emergency exists in view of the necessity to most expeditiously repair the boiler serving the Terminal Building at the Billings Logan International Airport and the public interest would be served by proceeding as hereinafter provided.

2. **THREE-FOURTHS VOTE.** That more than three-fourths (3/4) of the members of the Council present at this meeting have determined that an emergency exists and it is in the best public interest to proceed.

3. **METHOD OF PROCEDURE.** That the City Council directs that the Administrator and his designees proceed immediately to purchase repair work on the boiler in the Terminal Building at the Billings Logan International Airport.


