

RESOLUTION NO. 98- 17324

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA,  
DISCONTINUING AND VACATING THE SOUTHERLY FIVE (5)  
FEET OF THAT PORTION OF COLTON BOULEVARD  
ADJACENT TO WYNDHAM PARK SUBDIVISION.**

WHEREAS, a proper petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Billings, Montana, as per Section 22-601 BMCC, requesting discontinuance and vacation of **the southerly five (5) feet of that portion of Colton Boulevard adjacent to Wyndham Park Subdivision;** and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. **DISCONTINUANCE AND VACATION.** Pursuant to Sections 7-14-4114 and 7-14-4115, M.C.A., the following portion(s) of **Colton Boulevard** is/are hereby discontinued, abandoned and vacated as shown on EXHIBIT "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

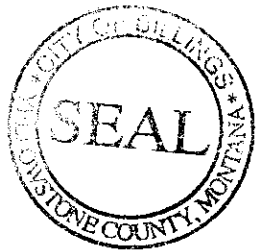
2. **PUBLIC INTEREST.** The discontinuance, vacation and abandonment of the above described portion of **Colton Boulevard** is in the best interest of the public and can be done without any public detriment.

3. **PROPERTY REVERSION.** Pursuant to Section 76-3-3005, the City Council of the City of Billings has given due consideration to the previous platting, the manner in which the right-of-way was originally dedicated, granted or conveyed, the reasons stated in the petition requesting the vacation, the parties requesting the vacation and any agreements between the adjacent property owners regarding the use of the vacated area." Based on that consideration, the vacated right-of-way shall revert to Lot 1, Block 1, Wyndham Park Subdivision.
