That the attached transfers or revisions are hereby adopted.



Buildingeye, Inc. is developing a web-based, building permit information map of Billings that will display the location of current and historic building permits at a cost of \$50,000 for 5 years. The user will be able to click on a permit icon and display Information about the permit, as well as define specific geographic areas to monitor building activity. The information is acquired from the building permit data in the City's electronic permitting system, Innoprise. Innoprise is charging \$14,000 to transfer the data daily via internet from Innoprise to the Buildingeye map interface. Reserves will be used for this expenditure.
