

ORDINANCE NO. 15 - 5660

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, PROVIDING THAT THE BILLINGS, MONTANA CITY CODE BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTIONS 2-565, 2-566, AND 2-567; CHANGING THE NAME OF THE PARKING ADVISORY BOARD TO THE BILLINGS PARKING BOARD AND UPDATING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY BILLINGS:

Section 1. That the title of Division 9 (Parking Advisory Board) and section 2-565 of the Billings, Montana City Code are amended so that they shall read as follows:

DIVISION 9. BILLINGS PARKING ~~ADVISORY~~ BOARD

Sec. 2-565. Created.

There is hereby created a parking ~~advisory~~ policy board to be named the Billings Parking Board.

Section 2. That section 2-566 of the Billings, Montana City Code is amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-566. Composition, appointment, term.

The ~~parking advisory~~ Billings Parking Board shall be composed of nine (9) members.

Section 3. That section 2-567 of the Billings, Montana City Code is amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-567. Powers and duties.

The ~~parking advisory~~ Billings Parking Board shall advise and make policy recommendations ~~and serve in an advisory capacity~~ to the city council in all aspects of parking within the city. The purpose of the board is to provide citizen input to the policy decisions of the city council. The primary responsibilities of the board are to provide input and policy recommendations on all aspects of public parking, including but not limited to, on-street parking, parking meters, parking garages, parking lots, long-range financial plans for parking, annual budget, operating and capital projects plans, parking fees, parking fines and other existing and proposed parking policies of the city, to report any shortcomings, and to make recommendations to the city council with regard to public parking.

DIVISION 9. - PARKING ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 2-567. - Powers and duties.

The parking advisory board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the city council in all aspects of parking within the city. The purpose of the board is to provide citizen input to the policy decisions of the city council. The primary responsibilities of the board are to provide input on all aspects of public parking, including but not limited to, on-street parking, parking meters, parking garages, long-range financial plans for parking, annual budget, operating and capital projects plans, parking fees, parking fines and other existing and proposed parking policies of the city, to report any shortcomings, and to make recommendations to the city council with regard to public parking.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. Repealer. All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.
