

RESOLUTION NO. 97- 17266

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 97-17245,
WHICH RESOLUTION APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL
YEAR 1997-98.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the 1997-1998 budget of the City of Billings, certain additional service needs have arisen which require the City to make certain additional expenditures and to incur certain liabilities; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the municipal budget to increase expenditure authority to pay the costs of increased services by the Building Division; and,

WHEREAS, state law requires a public hearing prior to final approval of a budget amendment which increases the total appropriation authority; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council should set a public hearing date and publish notice of said public hearing as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Resolution No. 97-17245 is hereby amended by the use of reserves in the amount of \$132,191.00 from Building Inspection Fund #209. Said funds are appropriated for use in the Building Division of the Public Works Department.

2. A public hearing shall be held on Monday, **September 8, 1997** at 7:30 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be considered, in the Council Chambers, located on the Second Floor of the Police Facility, 220 North 27th Street, Billings, Montana.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish notice of said hearing and of the preliminary approval of this resolution in the Billings Times on August 28 and September 4, 1997.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE: The budget amendment described above shall be effective upon final approval of this Resolution by the City Council.

Finally approved by the City Council on the 8th day of September, 1997.
