

RESOLUTION NO. 96- 17057

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF KING AVENUE EAST, BETWEEN WASHINGTON STREET AND THE CITY LIMITS BOUNDARY, APPROXIMATELY 600 FEET WEST OF ORCHARD LANE

WHEREAS, a petition requesting that parking be prohibited along the south side of King Avenue East, was submitted to the City Traffic Engineer by the Southwest Corridor Task Force, and

WHEREAS, said prohibition of parking will enhance the safety of pedestrians, bicyclists, and other non-motorized users traveling along the south side of King Avenue East, and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Control and Transit Board recommends approval of such a parking prohibition,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. All parking shall be prohibited along the south side of King Avenue East from a point where the City Limits Boundary crosses King Avenue East approximately 600 feet west of Orchard Lane, extending easterly to the intersection of King Avenue East and Washington Street on the east.
2. All resolutions and regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

PASSED by the City Council and APPROVED this 22nd day of January, 1996.
