

RESOLUTION NO. 96- 17086

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A PUBLIC EMERGENCY; STATING THE FACTS CONSTITUTING THE EMERGENCY; ESTIMATING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY REQUIRED TO MEET THE EMERGENCY AND THE FUND(S) AFFECTED.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the 1995-1996 budget of the City of Billings, certain public emergencies have arisen which require the City to make certain expenditures and to incur certain liabilities; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set forth the facts of the emergency as required by M.C.A. 7-6-4252; and

WHEREAS, the City Council shall cause that this resolution, together with notice of public hearing, shall be published as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council shall conduct a public hearing on the emergency and the proposed expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. EMERGENCY ADJUSTMENTS. That certain funds of the City are and will be overspent. The City has received some unanticipated revenues, and the use of the fund would best serve the public good if expended as provided herein. All increases in expenditures are covered either by increased revenues or by reserves. It is necessary that the city make emergency expenditures in the following funds for the emergency purposes stated.

a. HEALTH INSURANCE FUND.

(1) The appropriation for \$578,981 is for increasing the Budget Authority for Fund No. 270. These funds will be utilized for additional reimbursement of the 125)k) Plan, and health and dental claims.

b. TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

(1) The appropriation for \$50,516^{#30,516} is for increasing the Budget Authority for Fund No. 571. The additional funding for the MET Plus Ridership Program is \$30,516, and ~~\$20,000 is for the promotion and printing of materials for the implementation of the new Transit Route Schedules.~~

2. NOTICE. This resolution and a notice of public hearing to be held on Monday, May 13, 1996 at 7:30 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be considered in the Council Chambers, located on the Second Floor of the Police Facility, 220 North 27th Street, Billings,

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Montana and shall be published as required by law not less than one time before said hearing.

3. LIMITATION OF EXPENDITURES. That for a period of five (5) days following the public hearing and Council ordered expenditures, the City shall not make the expenditures appropriated herein.

PASSED by the City Council and APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY by all Councilmembers present this 22nd day of April, 1996.
