

RESOLUTION NO. 96- 17090

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK ONE OF LILLIS SUBDIVISION, 2ND FILING A ONE-WAY ALLEY SOUTHBOUND FROM LILLIS LANE TO LEWIS AVENUE

WHEREAS, a request to designate the alley in Block 1, Lillis Subdivision, 2nd Filing, as one-way southbound was submitted to the City Traffic Engineer, and

WHEREAS, said one-way alley designation will encourage motor vehicle traffic to stay on the arterial and collector street system rather than take short cuts through a residential area, and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Control and Transit Board recommends approval of said one-way traffic designation,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. The alley in Block 1, Lillis Subdivision, 2nd Filing be designated as a one-way alley, southbound from Lillis Lane to Lewis Avenue.
2. All resolutions and regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
