

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, DISCONTINUING AND VACATING COLTON BOULEVARD FROM 38TH STREET WEST TO SHILOH ROAD; SWANSON LANE FROM FAIRMEADOW DRIVE TO COLTON BOULEVARD; AND TANNER LANE FROM FAIRMEADOW DRIVE TO COLTON BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, a proper petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Billings, Montana, as per Section 22-601 BMCC, requesting discontinuance and vacation of Colton Boulevard: from 38th Street West to Shiloh Road; Swanson Lane: from Fairmeadow Drive to Colton Boulevard; and Tanner Lane: from Fairmeadow Drive to Colton Boulevard, as described hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the petition pursuant to Section 76-3-305 M.C.A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. DISCONTINUANCE AND VACATION. Pursuant to Sections 7-14-4114 and 7-14-4115, M.C.A., and due consideration, the following portion(s) of Colton Boulevard, Swanson Lane, and Tanner Lane is/are hereby discontinued, abandoned and vacated subject to conditions, if any, hereinafter imposed:

Colton Boulevard: From 38th Street West to Shiloh Road;

Swanson Lane: From Fairmeadow Drive to Colton Boulevard;

Tanner Lane: From Fairmeadow Drive to Colton Boulevard.

(The vacated area shall revert as follows:

1. The southerly 42 feet of the westerly 285 feet of Colton Boulevard shall revert to Lot 3A, Block 14 as shown on the plat of Circle Fifty Subdivision, Amended. The remainder of Colton Boulevard, together with a portion of Tanner Lane, shall revert to Poly Vista Park (Lot 1, Block 19, Circle Fifty Subdivision) as shown on the plat of Circle Fifty Subdivision, Amended.
2. Swanson Lane shall revert to Lots 3A and 4A, Block 14, as shown on the plat of Circle Fifty Subdivision, Amended.
3. Tanner Lane, with the exception of that portion reverting to Poly Vista Park, shall revert to Lots 11A and 12A, Block 14, as shown on the plat of Circle Fifty Subdivision, Amended.)

2. PUBLIC INTEREST. The discontinuance, vacation and abandonment of the above described portion of **Colton Boulevard, Swanson Lane, and Tanner Lane** is in the best interest of the public and can be done without any public detriment.
