Administrative Order Number 128, dated February 12, 2015, is hereby amended to adopt the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, 2015 Edition. All other portions of Administrative Order Number 128 as set out below remain in full force and effect.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the City Administrator in Section 6-201, BMCC, and Section 50-60-301(1)(b), MCA, the following building, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical codes and all accompanying appendices, amendments and modifications adopted by the Building Codes Bureau, Montana Department of Labor and Industry, as set out in the Administrative Rules of Montana, as amended from time to time, are hereby adopted by reference, except as otherwise noted in chapter 6 of the Billings, Montana, City Code and except any regulations not applicable to local government jurisdictions.

As specified in ARM 24.301.146(20) the department has deleted Section 3109 Swimming Pool Enclosures and Safety Devices in its entirety from the International Building Code and replaced that section with the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code (ISPSC) as adopted in [NEW RULE I].

(NEW RULE I) INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE OF INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE (ISPSC) (1) The department adopts and incorporates by reference the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, 2015 edition, published by the International Code Council unless another edition is specifically stated, together with the following amendments:

(a) Chapters 7 through 10, inclusive, are deleted in their entirety.
