A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS,  
MONTANA, DISCONTINUING AND VACATING Palladium  
Drive.

WHEREAS, a proper petition was filed with the City Council of the City of Billings, Montana, as per Section 22-601 BMCC, requesting discontinuance and vacation of Palladium Drive as described hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. DISCONTINUANCE AND VACATION. Pursuant to Sections 7-14-4114 and 7-14-4115, M.C.A., Palladium Drive;

Located in Copper Ridge Subdivision, 5<sup>th</sup> Filing, Recorded February 27, 2014, under Document No. 3698744, on file and of record in the Records of Yellowstone County, Bound on the north by Block 4, on the east by West Cooper Ridge Loop, on the south by Block 7 of said Copper Ridge Subdivision, 5<sup>th</sup> Filing, bound on the west by Certificate of Survey no. 2465 Amended; containing a Right-Of-Way area of 14,785 square feet, more or less. Including the adjoining existing "Temporary Turnaround Easement" per

Document No. 3458617 as depicted on the face of said Copper Ridge Subdivision, 5<sup>th</sup> Filing. As shown on Exhibit "A".


Is hereby discontinued, abandoned and vacated.
