

RESOLUTION 17-10670

A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE NOVEMBER 7, 2017 GENERAL ELECTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

WHEREAS, HB 447 passed by the 2017 Legislature (Chapter 174, Laws 2017) authorizes a municipality to cancel a general election for the election of a municipal officer by resolution after notification by the election administrator if the number of candidates filing for election is equal or less than the number of positions to be filled; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated, September 6, 2017, the City of Billings received notice by the Yellowstone County Election Administrator that the following elected municipal officer position is eligible for cancellation: Municipal Judge; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13-1-403, as amended by HB 83 (Chapter 242, Laws 2017), provides that a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate must be filed with the election administrator by 5 PM on the 65th day before the date of the election, or September 5, 2017; and

WHEREAS, as of September 5, 2017, the municipal officer position for Municipal Judge remains eligible for cancellation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. The City of Billings cancels the November 7, 2017 general election for Municipal Judge.
2. The following person is hereby elected by acclamation to Municipal Judge:
