Dress Code

This policy supersedes all previous policies and/or handbooks published by the City of Billings. Negotiated labor contracts that conflict with this policy will take precedence to the applicable extent.

Purpose

The appearance and demeanor of City employees has a great impact on citizens' perceptions and, consequently, their impression of the City of Billings.

The purpose of the policy is to provide City of Billings employees direction for appropriate appearance.

Policy

The employees' manner of dress is a reflection upon the City government. All employees are expected to dress appropriately and always be well groomed. Uniforms issued to department employees shall be properly worn (as instructed by the supervisor). At all times, regardless of style, attire should be neat, clean, modest, appropriate and professional. Department Heads and the employees' daily duties will determine appropriate attire.
