Section 4. That Section 2-506 of the Billings, Montana, City Code be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

**"Sec. 2-506. Vacancies.**

Vacancies occurring during the term shall be filled during the months of July or January, unless the Mayor determines that the vacancy must be filled sooner due to lack of a quorum. The member shall be appointed for the balance of the term."

Section 5. That Section 24-204 of the Billings, Montana, City Code be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

**"Sec. 24-204. Powers and duties.**

The traffic control board shall serve in an advisory capacity to the city council in all aspects of traffic control, except that all issues involving parking in the Central Business District will be handled by the Parking Advisory Board. The purpose of the board is to provide citizen input to the policy decisions of the city council. The primary responsibilities of the board are to review existing and proposed city policies and to review city department activities to ensure that city policies are being implemented and carried out and further to report any shortcomings and to make recommendations to the city council in the area of traffic control."

Section 6. That Sections 9-301 through 9-304 of the Billings, Montana, City Code, which create the Downtown Redevelopment Board and set its composition, appointment of members, organization, powers and duties, are hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.

Section 7. That subsections (b) and (c) of Section 2-830 of the Billings, Montana, City Code, which creates an Appeal Board for Access to Criminal History Records and sets the appointment of Board members, is hereby repealed and declared null and void and of no effect.

Section 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.

Section 9. REPEALER. All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
