

RESOLUTION 21-11017

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MASTER PLAN FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MULTI-GENERATIONAL COMMUNITY RECREATION CENTER FOR THE CITIZENS OF BILLINGS LOCATED ON CITY OWNED LAND NEXT TO AMEND PARK

WHEREAS, The South Billings Aquatic & Recreation Center Master Plan & Feasibility Study is the master plan for a Multi-Generational Community Recreation Center located on City owned land next to Amend Park.

WHEREAS, the public interest requires the creation and adoption of a Master Plan for a Multi – Generational Community Recreation Center located on City owned land next to Amend Park, to control and limit development in accordance with the needs of the community, the limitations and constraints of the site, and with improvements suited to and appropriate for the citizens for Billings; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a Community Recreation Center to meet the indoor recreational and sports tourism needs of the citizens of Billings; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and necessary that this plan guide the future development of a community recreation center; and

WHEREAS, this plan is in response to the public input and desires of the citizens of Billings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA:

1. *Master Plan.* The master plan for a Multi-Generational Community Recreation Center presented for adoption and attached as *Exhibit A* is the official Master Plan for the facility.

2. *General Character of Improvements Provided for by the Plan.* The general character of the improvements are intended to balance the indoor recreational and programming needs and opportunities for the citizens of Billings, The special events hosted at the facility and the programming the sports tourism needs and opportunities of the community and region.

3. *Future development.* The master plan will serve as a reference and guide for future study, design and construction efforts in the development of a Multi-Generational Recreation Community Center
