

## **2022 PARKS WI-FI PROJECT Request for Proposals (RFP)**

The following clarifications are provided to all proposers who have, or will, submit a completed ***Intent to Respond*** form prior to the RFP deadline of January 28, 2022.

1. **Section 2: Background, Introduction, Objectives & Goals – Project Locations & Site Visits, 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph, Page 7:**

In place of individually scheduled appointments, City of Billings' staff from the Parks, Recreation & Public Land Department and the Community Development Division encourage attendance at the optional Pre-Bid Conference (announced in Addendum #1) at 9:00 a.m. MST on Wednesday, January 19, 2022. This will be followed by tours of the eight (8) parks.

Proposers who are unable to attend the Pre-Bid Conference in person may attend virtually. **NOTE:** There will **NOT** be an opportunity to participate in the park tours portion via Zoom.

2. City staff will provide printed copies of each park's aerial photograph during the Pre-Bid Conference (created using the free online Google Earth application). Simple markings indicating known existing electrical assets and/or potential locations for electrical services will be included on the printed photographs. To scale diagrams and/or drawings will NOT be provided.
