The meeting was held in Zimmerman Park Bldg located in Pioneer Park. Fifteen persons signed the list, including a representative from the City, Deb Meling and Councilman Ed Gulick. The Pledge was recited.

Deb Mehling spoke at length about the new garbage can situation in our neighborhood. Most all 300 galloon receptables will be replaced by 90 galloon receptables. At this time, the city will not change our price structure, however there will be adjustments as times goes on. Deb also talked about many Public Water Dept projects this year, including the lead base piping on Avenue D. Other projects mentioned are the Zimmerman Trail, 32nd & King Ave, and south side graveled streets.

Councilman Ed Gullick spoke about the zone changes, etc at the Elks Club and multifamily housing.

Sgt Ben Milliam gave us an updated crime report. He told us to be aware of walking pedestrians who may be wearing back packs and appear to be suspicious. Thefts increase as weather warms up. He mentioned catalytic converters and street crime

We hope to host an ice cream social, perhaps a photo shoot of owners dogs and cats, music from folks in our subdivision and just ways to "get acquainted with neighbors.
