

ORDINANCE 25-5918

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, PROVIDING THAT SECTION 24-601 OF THE BILLINGS, MONTANA CITY CODE (BMCC) BE AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS THAT:

Section 1. That Section 24-601 of the Billings, Montana City Code (BMCC) is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24-601. Parking.

- (a) With the exception of authorized law enforcement personnel, no person shall park a bicycle upon a street, other than upon the roadway against the curb or upon the sidewalk in a rack to support the bicycle or against a building or at the curb, in such a manner as to afford the least obstruction to pedestrian traffic.
- (b) With the exception of authorized law enforcement personnel, no person shall leave a bicycle unsecured in a public place.
- (c) "Unsecured bicycle" shall be defined as an unattended bicycle which does not have an independent locking device affixed thereto in a manner so as to deter theft of the bicycle.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.

Section 3. REPEALER. All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the

other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
