

RESOLUTION NO. 10-18916

A RESOLUTION OF THE BILLINGS, MONTANA, CITY COUNCIL, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF UP TO \$11,000 FROM FY 2010 CITY COUNCIL CONTINGENCY FUNDS FOR INSTALLATION OF A 2-INCH WATER METER FOR A NEW CENTENNIAL PARK LITTLE LEAGUE BALLFIELD

WHEREAS, Montana District 1 Little League was awarded a \$99,000 grant from Major League Baseball and the Major League Baseball Players Association through the Baseball Tomorrow Fund for construction of a new, full-sized baseball field at Centennial Park; and

WHEREAS, District 1 Little League has raised an additional \$87,000 through league and private donations and pledges to complete the initial development of the field; and

WHEREAS, District 1 Little League provides funding and volunteer labor to help clean up and maintain baseball and softball fields at City parks each summer; and

WHEREAS, it was determined in discussions between the City's Parks, Recreation & Public Lands Department and District 1 Little League that a 1-inch water meter currently at Centennial Park would need to be upgraded to a 2-inch meter to satisfy all the needs of the new field and surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the meter is estimated to be \$11,000, an expense for which District 1 Little League had not planned, and which it has asked the Council to contribute to the project to help improve the park.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, to authorize the expenditure of up to \$11,000 from the Council Contingency Fund (Account 010-1110-411.79-70) for the installation of a 2-inch water meter at Centennial Park.
