

RESOLUTION NO. 10-18938

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY IN REGARD TO REPAIRS AT DEHLER PARK

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2010, a traffic accident caused damage estimated in excess of \$20,000 to the field and infrastructure of Dehler Park, which is owned by the City of Billings; and

WHEREAS, Dehler Park is scheduled to be used for American Legion tournament games on the weekend of May 14, requiring the field and infrastructure to be repaired on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, MCA 7-5-4303 provides for emergency purchases to be handled in a way that best meets the emergency if approved by a three-quarters vote of the Council present at the meeting and duly recorded in the minutes of the meeting; and

WHEREAS, Purchasing Procedure VII.7. Emergency Purchases also allows the requirement for sealed bids for emergency purchases over \$20,000 to be waived and an emergency purchase to be made in the fastest possible manner if authorized by City Council resolution and recorded in the minutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, that an emergency purchase be declared in the case of repairs for the May 8, 2010, damage to Dehler Park.
