

## City of Billings Emergency Declaration Resolution No. 10-18959

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2010, a severe summer storm with multiple tornadoes caused extensive damage to various areas within the City of Billings, including private and publicly owned property;

WHEREAS, several hundred persons and properties have been affected with hail and wind damage, power failure and massive flooding. The City of Billings has experienced the need to activate the City/County Emergency Operations Center and several additional fire, police and public works personnel to address public safety concerns, assist with flooding, restore necessary services, crowd control, etc.;

WHEREAS, the City/County EOC activated the Montana National Guard through MTDES for security and law enforcement assistance for damaged business and commercial property;

WHEREAS, the City of Billings does recognize the potential economic and financial impact as a result of the extraordinary costs of support services and repair of the damages as a result of this massive storm;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED pursuant to Title 10, Chapter 3, Part 4, MCA, by Thomas W. Hanel, Mayor of the City of Billings that an emergency is hereby declared, the City/County Emergency Operations Plan will be in effect for the duration of this event, and I request the Governor of the State of Montana declare an emergency/disaster to assist the City of Billings with resources as needed and financial assistance;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution will be filed with the Yellowstone County Clerk and Recorder and Montana Disaster and Emergency Services in Helena.


