

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-19016**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, CITY COUNCIL, CREATING AN AD-HOC COMMITTEE TO CONSIDER A PROPOSED GIFT OF ART TO THE CITY OF BILLINGS FROM MIKE MCFADDEN.**

**WHEREAS**, Billings artist Mike McFadden has offered to donate to the City of Billings his approximately 30-by-40-inch painting of Sacrifice Cliff entitled "Magic"; and

**WHEREAS**, Billings City Council Resolution No. 04-18101 requires a 5-member, ad hoc review committee be appointed by the Council to make recommendations on the appropriateness and placement of public art. The Committee shall consist of two members who are skilled and/or trained in the evaluation of art to be named by the Mayor; two representatives who have an interest in art but are not involved in the creation or donation of the piece of art under consideration; and a member of the Parks, Recreation and Cemetery Board to be appointed by that board; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS, MONTANA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:**

1. To confirm the Mayor's appointment of Charles Fritz and Carolyn Thayer as those who are skilled and/or trained in the evaluation of art; and
2. To appoint Michael Capser and Donna Forbes as representatives with an interest in art who are not involved in the creation or donation of the piece of art under consideration; and
3. To confirm the appointment of whatever member is designated by the Parks, Recreation and Cemetery Board at its meeting on January 12, 2011.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the ad-hoc committee is to present a recommendation to the City Council by February 21, 2011, on the appropriateness and placement of the art being donated by Mr. McFadden.
